Greetings from IMS Ghaziabad!!!

Technotsav-2019 is the annual I.T fest of Institute of Management studies (IMS), Ghaziabad. This I.T-Fest aims to provide a platform for the students of many UG courses form all over India to showcase their technical prowess, talent and enthusiasm. The activities culminate in a grand one day Fest in the campus of IMS, Ghaziabad. It will include various events viz. Dazzle Coding, Gamers Den (IT Game), IT Quiz (Techno-Gyan), IoT SQUAD, Appathon (Website/Android Application Development) and Poster Presentation.

General Guidelines:

1. Participants must bring their original College ID Card/ College Proof.
2. Outstation Participants must produce their original tickets for reimbursements
3. Any participant caught cheating will be disqualified.
4. Judges decision will be final decision
5. Hostel Accommodation can be provided to outstation participants on prior request.

Event Specific Rules & Regulations

Codex (Dazzle Coding)

Two programs will be given to each participant. They have to code with their monitors off. The winner will be decided on the basis of completion of task with minimum no. of errors.

Rules & Regulations:

1. Individual participation.
2. Every participant will get two problems to solve within the specified time duration.
3. Problems can be coded in any language (C/C++/ JAVA.... etc.).
4. Every participant can use rough papers provided by the institution for any calculations/logical building.
5. At the time of coding the screen will remain off.
6. Maximum Duration of the event is 2 hour.

IoT Squad

IOT Squad provides a platform to inspire the innovator within. The Technology, by what it does directly and through others, helps build a civil society that enables everyone to live life better in a world driven by technology.

Rules and Regulation

1. Maximum 2 Members in a Team
2. 5 Teams will qualify for FINAL ROUND
3. Shortlisted Teams have to submit abstract of the model in final round.

Poster Presentation

A poster is a graphically based approach to present thoughts/ideas. Poster presentation is scheduled at “TECHNOTSAV 2019” to encourage the graduate students to showcase their academic & professional knowledge. This competition aims at setting a platform for all the budding technocrats to present their original work and share views related to the theme.

Rules and Regulation

1. It is a Team event with at most two members in each team.
2. Poster topics may be related to IT/Science topics.
3. Participants shall plot the idea on a poster. All illustrations and text must be readable from a distance of 3 feet.
4. Participants will be given Five-minute to present their ideas followed by a five-minute question-and-answer round.
5. Institution will provide a mounting space and mounting materials such as tape or push pins. Competitors may choose to orient the poster vertically or horizontally.
6. Size of Poster- Chart Paper.

I.T Quiz

It has been designed as an innovative, interactive manner to facilitate a copious flow of knowledge and ideas packaged in exciting rounds to benchmark knowledge with others in an environment of healthy competition and lots of fun.

Rules and Regulation

1. Only team entries are eligible with two participants in a team from same institution.
2. The duration of event is 2 hrs.
3. Questions are related to IT/Science/ Current Affairs.
4. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile or other electronic gadgets.
5. The questions shall be in the form of multiple choice, True / False statement, Specific-answer question etc in all the Rounds.
6. In Case of Tie in any stage, then Rapid Fire Round will be conducted for final selections.

Appathon

Appathon is an application development contest. The participants are encouraged to design, develop and present a mobile application or web application. The application can be developed on any Mobile or Web platform like Android, Windows etc.

Rules and Regulation

1. It is a team event. At most 2 members can be in a team.
2. The participants will have to design and develop an innovative solution for a defined problem(s).
3. The platforms can be any open source Mobile or Web Platform like Android, Chrome and Web Apps.
4. The duration of event is 2 hours (Duration can be changed on spot as per discretion of event organizers)

5. The participants are advised to bring in their own laptops with their preferred environment already set up. No extra time will be given for setting up environment.
6. Usage of free and/or open source resources is allowed, but plagiarism and cheating is not.
7. Every application will be evaluated in 4 categories – User Interface, User Experience, Usefulness and Innovativeness.

Gamers Den

Counter-Strike (CSGame version - Half-Life Counter-Strike 1.6) is a series of multiplayer first-person shooter video games, in which teams of terrorists and terrorists' battle to, respectively, perpetrate an act of terror (bombing, hostage-taking) and prevent it (bomb defusal, hostage rescue) -

Rules and Regulation

1. The Half-Life Counter-Strike PC game championship 4x4 (team play, 4 members per team).
2. Fest Organizers reserves the right to cancel or modify the tournament rules if fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond reasonable control, impairs the integrity of the tournament
3. A game consists of 2 periods, each period including 4 rounds. A round lasts 3 minutes. One period as terrorists and the other as counter-terrorists for each team
4. The duration of event is 2 hrs (Duration can be changed on spot as per discretion of Judges)
5. Matches will be Knockout based.
6. Toss will decide the team role defence / attack.
